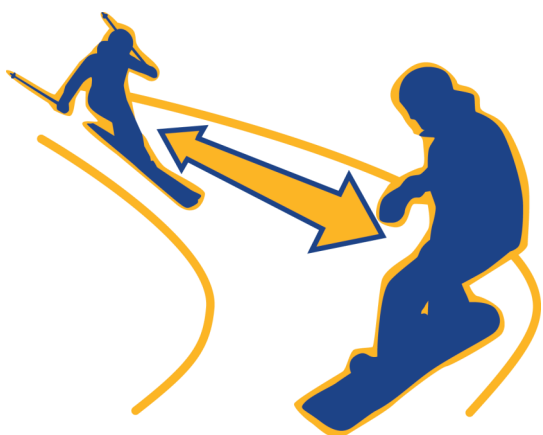

POWDER RIDGE COVID-19 OPERATING PLAN

Here is how Powder Ridge is helping keep our employees, guests and community healthy:

FACE COVERING REQUIREMENTS

Powder Ridge will require face coverings that align with CDC recommendations. Face coverings must be worn in all indoor spaces, except when eating or drinking; and outdoors whenever physical distancing cannot be achieved.

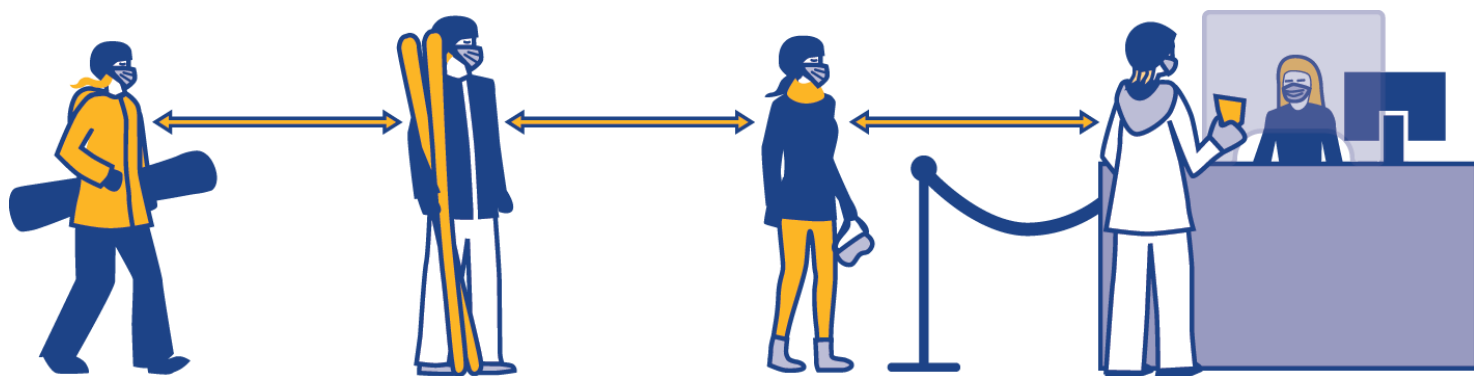


NEW SEATING AVAILABLE!

PHYSICAL DISTANCING

Powder Ridge will create operational adjustments that allow for appropriate spacing between parties. This includes, but is not limited to: lift lines, front desk lines, food and beverage outlets, chalet tables, lessons and employee spaces. Guests are advised to follow physical distancing protocols of 6 feet when around people outside of their party.

Due to spacing tables out in the chalet, a heated tent has been added to the Powder Ridge operation to create additional space for warming up outdoors. Chalet space will be limited.





TRAVEL TOGETHER, RIDE TOGETHER

Groups will be given designated chalet space, and asked to only sit in their group area. Guests will also be asked to self-group and load lifts with their traveling party. Lift attendants will not require guests to ride a chairlift with people they do not know. Powder Ridge strongly suggests that guests wear face coverings whenever physical distancing cannot be achieved outdoors.

SKI SCHOOL/LESSONS

Ski School class sizes will be operating at a reduced size to accommodate physical distancing. All Ski School Instructors will be required to wear a face covering during lessons.



FOOD SERVICES

Ridgeview Kitchen will no longer be self serve; instead our staff will be handing food out to guests. Please help us by asking your group to eat in shifts to reduce the line during meal times. Chester's Bar & Grill will have limited seating capacity.

RENTAL SHOP

Cleaning and disinfecting of all equipment will be done per CDC recommendations between each user. Extra spacing created in boot area.



CLEANING & DISINFECTION

Powder Ridge staff will be disinfecting high-touch areas per CDC recommendations. Sanitation stations will be available throughout the resort for guest and employee use.

STAY HOME IF SICK

Please do your part in protecting others, and stay home or go home when experiencing the following symptoms: muscle aches, headache, loss of smell or taste, sore throat, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath, fatigue.



Powder Ridge will perform daily wellness checks of all employees prior to the start of their shift.

To save space inside our chalet this season, please get dressed in your vehicle or on the bus. Powder Ridge will not be allowing large ski bags or skis/boards inside the chalet. Please leave your extra belongings in your vehicle or on the bus!
