

## Cardinal Cruisers Ski & Snowboard Club 2019 / 2020 Welcome Letter

Welcome to the 2019/2020 season of Cardinal Cruisers Ski & Snowboard Club (CCS&SC). Thank you for sending your child out to Powder Ridge with us. We hope they have a good time snowboarding and skiing this year.

Our first meeting is this Monday, December 2<sup>nd</sup>. With recent snow and the fact that Powder Ridge has been busy most of November making snow in the colder weather, multiple runs are open.

The first Monday is rather chaotic, we have a large group again, and a location that's smaller than desired. Please pay special attention to these details to make sure things go smoothly.

- **Busses** leave from AES and AMS right after school. The AES bus goes to AHS after all the elementary kids are boarded. The AES kids should meet in the cafeteria where a club coordinator (Josh Trutwin or Sarah Jensen) will take attendance and assist with boarding. The AMS kids will board at the side door by the parking lot. A club coordinator (usually Sarah Wiles) will be present at AMS to assist and take attendance. The AHS students should wait for the bus to arrive from AES by the office. The AHS bus boards at the rear school entrance. The busses normally arrive at Powder Ridge around 3:45. The AMS bus arriving 5-10 minutes earlier than AES/AHS.
- **Parents are welcome** to come out any time, feel free to join your kids on the slopes too. Powder Ridge has given us sole usage of the downstairs area which is also the Powder Ridge Kids Club room. This is a private room reserved for our group. It is downstairs to the left immediately after entering the main chalet doors.
- **Pack WARM** gear for your kids, layers, extra gloves, socks, hand warmers, etc. Club will cancel on occasion for sub-zero temps and/or wind chill, but often we have nights that are pretty frigid especially if the wind kicks up. Keep in mind that your kids might wind up playing outside in wet snow for school recess so an extra set of gloves for club use only might be a good idea. Powder Ridge has glove warmers next to the main ticket office, they cost 2 quarters per use.
- Make sure your child has a plan for **supper**. Either pack food or make sure they have money to buy food at the chalet. Powder Ridge has a cafeteria style food service area that serves hamburgers, pizzas, fries, and sometimes a special that doesn't come out of a deep fat fryer. The worst thing as a coordinator that I've had to deal with is a kid begging for money because they have nothing to eat. NOTE Kids are not able to order from Chester's Lounge upstairs without an adult present.
- Make sure your child **knows their schedule** – whether or not they ride the bus to/from school to Powder Ridge, etc.
- If you are picking up your child from Powder Ridge, please come downstairs and **sign them out** so we know they are not riding the bus.
- We will try to have at least 7-8 **chaperones** with us on the slopes or in the chalet at all times and there should always be at least one club coordinator in our downstairs area. Sarah has out a separate email regarding chaperone responsibilities. If you are interested in chaperoning and didn't get this email let us know.

For those that purchased Rental packages and/or lessons:

- Do NOT print any online rental forms and send them with your child, they must **pick up their rental card/form** from a club coordinator before going to the rental line.
- We will **pre-label the first night's rental forms** again this year so they don't have to fill out their name, address and phone. We have included the experience level, height, weight and shoe size on the rental forms to expedite this process. NOTE: We are working with Powder Ridge to have the season rental cards ready on the first night.
- After or hopefully on the first night anyone who purchased package 1 will also get their **season rental pass card** good for rentals any time the rest of the season. NOTE this does not include helmet rentals.
- If you purchased **lessons** for your child make sure you instruct them to actually go to the lessons. They start at 4:00 and last for one hour. They meet at the bottom of the bunny hill. If they miss the 4:00 lesson there are additional lessons at 5:00.
- Each child is permitted a **ONE-TIME free switch** on their rental between ski and snowboard. This is only use if your child wants to try a different activity than they normally do.
- If you purchase your own equipment for Christmas or otherwise you can receive a **refund** on your season rental card in the form of a Powder Ridge gift card.
- Chaperones will be available to assist with the rental process.

A couple other notes specific to parents:

- We are not a day care service. We cannot keep tabs on every kid at every minute of the night. We have 2 coordinators and 6-7 chaperones for close to 100 members. **IT IS CRUCIAL THAT YOUR CHILD SHOULD BE ABLE TO HANDLE THEMSELVES FOR LONG PERIODS OF UNSUPERVISED TIME, IF THEY CANNOT DO THIS YOU MUST BE PRESENT WITH THEM TO CONTINUE ENROLLMENT IN THE CLUB.**
- The above point is especially true if your child is in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade or lower and does not have an older sibling in the club, please consider coming to Powder Ridge to help them out. Even if they have skied or snowboarded before, it can be intimidating for kids this young to be on their own for this amount of time.
- **Please let us know if your child will not be riding the bus from school to Powder Ridge**, this will help us with bus attendance. If you are providing transportation, please try to be at Powder Ridge no earlier than 3:30pm.
- Please let us know if your child is missing club night for any reason, or if there are any changes in transportation.
- If your child is injured, we can provide a pro-rated refund for any missed lift tickets in the form of a Powder Ridge gift card.
- Missing club results in loss of lift ticket – see <http://www.cardinalcruisers.com/faq/> page for more information on cancellations, absences, refunds, etc.
- **If you pick up your child from Powder Ridge you must sign them out downstairs in our area.** If anyone other than a parent is signing your child out the parent must first contact a club coordinator.
- The bus from Powder Ridge to Annandale leaves at 8:00 SHARP, we will do 1<sup>st</sup> call at approximately 7:30. Depending on where the kids are on the hill it can be hard to hear the announcements so please make sure your child knows to watch for the clock or check a watch /

phone / etc. There are clocks by the chair lift entrances and exits, if you know where to look (inside the worker warming hut)... Chaperones will be also taking roll at bus departure so we know who boarded the bus.

- The busses drop off at AMS around 8:20pm. PLEASE be prompt in picking up your child. A coordinator must stay at AMS until all children have been picked up. We will get crabby if we have to wait for late parents while their kids stand outside in the cold! One bus will travel from AMS to AHS for those high schoolers who drive themselves to school but take the bus to Powder Ridge.
- If you would like the bus to drop your child off in South Haven at Mom's Restaurant at approximately 8:15pm, please let us know and we will coordinate with the bus company.
- Pictures are currently scheduled for our THIRD meeting, December 16<sup>th</sup>. We will send the Zahler Photography order form in a separate email and they will be available to the kids on the second club night to take home.
- Behavior issues will be met with very low tolerance and depending on the severity could result in expulsion from the club without refund. This includes fighting, drug/alcohol use (including vaping), theft, vandalism, bus behavior, etc.
- Each office has a place where kids can store their equipment – contact your school office for details. M&M requires that all ski/snowboard be stored in a bag.
- If your child loses something we do not maintain our own lost and found – please have them check with Powder Ridge at the front desk or contact M&M for any items left on the bus.
